

# Georgia Casualties At Champion Hill (Baker's Creek)

May 16, 1863

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Listed below are Georgia Infantry casualties at the Battle of Champion Hill, which took place on May 16, 1863.

Confederate records, to say the least, are not totally accurate. However, some records are better than no records.

Most of the captured Confederates were sent to Ft. Delaware Prison in Delaware and either died, were paroled, or exchanged.

Please note that I have entered the name of several soldiers who were captured at Edward's Station, MS., near Champion Hill, within several days after the battle. I believe these soldiers were captured as a result of the Battle of Champion Hill.
