Most of the captured Confederates were sent to Ft. Delaware Prison in Delaware and either died, were paroled, or exchanged.

Please note that I have entered the name of several soldiers who were captured at Edward's Station, MS. within several days after the battle. I believe this was a result of the Battle of Champion Hill.
